Kadosh – set-apart / Holy

Kedoshim (plural) – Set-Apart Ones

What does it mean to be a kedoshim?



 You are now kedoshim – but do you fully understand what that means?

- Do you live like it?
 - How do you know if you have never experienced it?
 - What instructions were given to those that were kedoshim?

Kedoshim

 This Parasha is filled with instructions on how to be kedoshim (set-apart ones)

- As kedoshim (set-apart ones) we are instructed to GUARD / KEEP things kadosh (set-apart)
 - The Levites primary job was to instruct the Tribes of Ysirael and teach them the Torah and how to guard/keep it (establishing boundaries in a sense)

How are we Kadosh?

• Leviticus 11:44

 "For I am YAHWEH your Elohim, and you shall set yourselves apart. And you shall be set-apart, for I AM setapart..."

Leviticus 19:2

 "Speak to all the congregation of the children of Yisrael, and say to them, "Be set-apart, for I YAHWEH your Elohim am set-apart"

He makes us Kadosh (Set-Apart) for He is Kadosh

- Our works do not set us apart, our obedience does
- He instructs us to set ourselves apart from the rest of the nations

Yahshua's Instructions

Matthew 19

- "Noone is good except one ELOHIM (YAHWEH).
 But if you wish to enter into life, <u>GUARD THE</u> <u>COMMANDS!!!</u>
 - You shall not murder (Exo 20:13-16) & (Duet 5:17-20)
 - <u>You shall not commit adultery</u> (Exo 20:13-16) & (Duet 5:17-20)
 - You shall not steal (Exo 20:13-16) & (Duet 5:17-20)
 - <u>You shall not bear false witness</u> (Exo 20:13-16) & (Duet 5:17-20)
 - **Respect your father and your mother**
 - <u>You shall love your neighbor as yourself</u> (Exo 20:12 & Deut 5:16)

 Exo 20:13-16 "You do not murder. You do not commit adultery. You do not steal. You do not bear false witness against your neighbor"

 Deut 5: 17-20 You do not murder. You do not commit adultery. You do not steal. You do not bear false witness against your neighbor.

 Lev 19:18 'Do not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the children of your people.
 And you shall love your neighbor as yourself.
 I am יהוה.

KEDOSHIM

- We see that Yahshua was not giving the disciples new commands
- HE was reinforcing His Father's commands
- If we want to enter into eternal life, what are we supposed to do?
 - Keep / Guard the commands
 - Those who are Kadosh (set-apart) are those that keep / guard the commands

Yahshua's promise to the Disciples

- Matthew 19:16-30
 - When the Son of Adam sits on the throne of HIS esteem
 - You who have followed Me in the rebirth, shall also sit on 12 thrones, judging the 12 Tribes of Israel
 - Everyone who has left houses, brothers, sisters, father's and mother's or wife or children or lands, <u>FOR</u> <u>MY NAMES SAKE</u>
 - SHALL RECEIVE 100 FOLD AND SHALL INHEIRIT EVERLASTING LIFE. BUT MANY WHO ARE FIRST SHALL BE LAST AND THE LAST FIRST.

'Importance of HIS NAME'

Leviticus 18:4-5 "Do MY right-rulings and guard MY laws, to walk in them. I am YAHWEH, your Elohim. And you shall guard MY laws and MY right-rulings, which a man does and lives by them. I am YAHWEH."

Yahshua's Instructions

- Mark 12:29-31
 - The MOST IMPORTANT COMMAND
 - Hear o Yisrael, Yahweh our Elohim, Yahweh is ONE. And you shall love Yahweh your Elohim with all your heart, with all your being and with all your might. (Deut 6:4-5)
 - The second is this
 - You shall love your neighbor as yourself. (Lev 19:18)
- <u>THERE IS NO OTHER COMMANDMENTs</u> <u>GREATER THAN THESE</u>

 Deut 6:4-5 Hear, O Yisra'ěl: יסטי Elohim, is one! "And you shall love ויהוה your Elohim with all your heart, and with all your being, and with all your might.

 Lev 19:18 'Do not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the children of your people. And you shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am יהוה.

 Deut 4:35 You have been shown it, to know that יהוה Himself is Elohim; there is no one beside Him.

Kedoshim

- We see here, again, that Yahshua was not giving the disciples new commands
- HE was reinforcing His Father's commands
- What did Yashua agree with what the scribe stated?
 - That keeping these 2 commands is much more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices
 - Yahshua stated "You are not far from the Kingdom of Yahweh"

Leviticus 18:4-5 "Do MY right-rulings and guard MY laws, to walk in them. I am YAHWEH, your Elohim. And you shall guard MY laws and MY right-rulings, which a man does and lives by them. I am YAHWEH."

Yahshua's Instructions

- Luke 10:25-37
 - What is written in the Torah? How do you read it?
 - You have answered correctly, do this and you will live
 - WHO IS MY NEIGHBOR?
 - Many opinions out there in response to this
 - Yahshua made it clear in this parable who's our neighbor
 - **GO AND DO LIKEWISE** (showing MERCY)

Deut 6:5 "And you shall love יהוה your
 Elohim with all your heart, and with all your
 being, and with all your might.

- Lev 19:18 'Do not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the children of your people. And you shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am יהוה.
- Lev 18:5 'And you shall guard My laws and My right-rulings, which a man does and lives by them. I am יהוה.

Kedoshim

- We see here, for a THIRD TIME, that Yahshua was not giving the disciples new commands
- HE was reinforcing His Father's commands
- What was Yahshua's response to the learned one in the Torah after he answered Yahshua's question?
 - You have answered correctly, DO THIS and you will live ; in reference to the 2 greatest commands

• <u>Can I get an amen on the</u> <u>account of 2 or 3</u> <u>witnesses?</u>

- We just read 3 witness accounts of the words of our Messiah, stating the same thing in all 3 accounts...
- KEDOSHIM / KADOSH
 THERE SEEMS TO BE A PATTERN HERE

Leviticus 18:4-5 "Do MY right-rulings and guard MY laws, to walk in them. I am YAHWEH, your Elohim. And you shall guard MY laws and MY right-rulings, which a man does and lives by them. I am YAHWEH."

As Kedoshim We are <u>REDEEMED</u>!

- We belong to HIM. We are asked to love HIM and walk in HIS ways. We are no longer slaves to our flesh.
- As a Redeemed Kedoshim
 - WE Do not live like we lived before being redeemed (teshuva – we have turned back to our KING)
 - WE constantly cut away those things of the old, put on the new as redeemed (new wine does not go into old wine skin)

- Free will to follow HIS Commands or not
 - Those that follow have a heart to obey and the faith HE is our Elohim. We desire to do HIS ways, not our own or the ways of the world.
 - Those that do not follow: don't have the heart to obey, therefore HE is not and CANNOT be their Elohim. They refuse HIM and rebel against HIS commands.

1 Peter1:14

"as OBEDIENT children, <u>not</u> conforming yourselves to the former lusts of your ignorance, instead, as the ONE who called you is KADOSH, so you also shall become KADOSH in all behavior, because it is written, Be KADOSH, for I AM KADOSH!" (Lev 11:44 & 19:2)

- Biblical love
 - Deut 11:1 "And you shall love YAHWEH your Elohim and guard HIS charge, even HIS laws, and HIS right rulings and HIS commands, <u>ALWAYS</u>."
 - Deut 30:16 "in that I am commanding you today to love YAHWEH your Elohim, to walk in HIS ways, and to guard HIS commands, and HIS laws and His right-rulings."

- John 14:15 "If you love ME, you shall guard MY commands."
- John 14:21 "He who possesses MY commands and guards them, it is he who loves ME. And he who loves ME shall be loved by MY FATHER, and I shall love him and manifest MYSELF to him."
- John 14:23 Yahshua answered him, "If anyone loves ME, he shall guard MY WORD. And MY FATHER shall love him, and WE shall come to him and make OUR stay with him."

- John 15:10 "If your guard MY commands, you shall stay in MY love, even as I have guarded MY FATHER'S commands and stay in HIS love."
- 1John 5:2-3 "By this we know that we love the children of YAHWEH, when we love YAHWEH and guard HIS commands, for this is the love for YAHWEH, that we guard HIS commands..."

Kedoshim

- How do we become Kedoshim?
 - By Keeping His Commandments (being set-apart)
 - We keep them because we love HIM
 - We understand Biblical Love to be different than the western understanding of emotional love

Blessings for the Matriarchs

An accomplished woman who can find? Her value is far beyond rubies. Her husband's heart trusts in her, and he lacks nothing valuable. She brings him good and not harm all the days of her life. She selects wool and flax and her hands work willingly. She is like merchant ships, bringing her sustenance from afar. She rises while it is still night and provides food for her household and portions for her servant girls. She considers a field and buys it. From the fruit of her hands she plants a vineyard. She girds herself with strength and invigorates her arms. She discerns that her business is good. Her lamp never goes out at night. She extends her hands to the spindle and her palm grasps the spinning wheel. She spreads out her palms to the poor, and extends her hands to the needy.

Blessing for the Mothers

She watches over the affairs of her household, and does not eat the bread of idleness. Her children arise and bless her, her husband also praises her: "Many daughters have excelled, but you surpass them all."
