Yovel (Jubilee) Facts

Sabbaticals and Jubilees KEYS TO THE SAVIOR'S RETURN

- **It is a Shabbat (Rest)**
- **Cannot be declared until all the nations of the 12 tribes return to the land**
- **This is a One Day Only Event**
 - Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement)
- **Only the High Priest can declare Yovel**

Shabbat Recap

- Exodus 20:8-11

– *“Remember the Sabbath, to set it apart. 6 days you labor and shall do all your work, but the 7th day is a Sabbath of YAHWEH your Elohim. You do not do any work – you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates. For in 6 days YAHWEH made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the 7th day. Therefore YAHWEH blessed the Sabbath and set-it apart.”*

Who was the Sabbath made for?

- Some contend and say that the Sabbath is only for the Jews
- Really?
 - How do we know which cattle are Jewish?
- Notice the commandment to keep/guard the Sabbath even includes the stranger (sojourner/gentile) within your gates

Parasha (Luke 4: 16-21)

- ***BREAKING NEWS***

- Evidence in this Book Confirms:

- Yahshua's custom was to be in the Synagogue on Shabbat
- The scroll of Isaiah was handed to Him
- He then quoted Isaiah and proclaimed that on that very day, the scripture He had just read, had been fulfilled.



Yahshua Quoted “Isaiah 61:1-3”

*“The Spirit of the Master יהוה is upon Me, because יהוה has anointed Me to bring good news to the meek. He has sent Me to bind up the broken-hearted, **to proclaim release to the captives**, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound, to proclaim the **acceptable year of יהוה**, and the day of vengeance of our Elohim, to comfort all who mourn, to appoint unto those who mourn in Tsiyon: to give them embellishment for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. And they shall be called trees of righteousness, a planting of יהוה, to be adorned.”*

Parasha (Luke 13:1-35)

- Yahshua healed a woman on the *Sabbath* (verses 12-13)
- The ruler of the assembly attempted to reprimand Yahshua, it was unsuccessful
- The woman healed was called a daughter of Abraham
 - This should ring some bells? Yes?
 - We are all of the seed of Abraham

Yahshua reinforces keeping Torah

- Similar phrases to Matthew 5:17-20 used
 - *Depart from me, all you workers of unrighteousness*
 - Those who say His Torah is done away with, just may hear these heartbreaking words out of Messiah's mouth directly
 - *He will say, I do not know where you are from*
 - If we are not of the 12 tribes of Israel, these words will be said to us

Shemittah

A year of faith

- **Every 50th year is supposed to be a Shemittah/Sabbatical/Jubilee year**
 - A year of rest for
 - The people
 - The land
 - The animals
 - *A renewing, a rejuvenation, a restoration*



Yahshua's Millennial Kingdom

- **Millennial**
 - Means a 1000 year period of time
 - Said to be a time of rest (Shabbat)
- **Millennial Kingdom (Rev. 20:1-6)**
 - The Set Apart are blessed
 - They will be Priests and reign with Yahshua for 1000 years
 - Will not experience the 2nd death

10 Lost Tribes Returning?

- **Verse 29**

- **And they shall come from the east and the west, and from the north and the south, and sit down in the reign of Elohim**

- **Is this the description of the lost 10 tribes return**

- **This is very similar to the account of Messiah's 2nd coming for His elect (Matthew 24:31)**

- **“and He shall send His messengers with a great sound of a trumpet (shofar), and they shall gather together His chosen ones from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.”**

Yovel facts

- **A true Yovel has not been declared since the 10 northern tribes were cast out into the Diaspora**
 - This was around 722 BCE
 - A true yovel has yet been declared since
 - It's impossible to since the 10 tribes are still dispersed
- **One thing we can count on, the Yovel will be declared by Yahshua at His second coming, during the fall Feasts (Moedim) and here is how we know this:**

The Fall Moedim You Say?

- He will return at the sound of the last Shofar (1st Corinthians 15:51-52) – *Yom Teruah*
 - “See I speak a secret to you; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the *last shofar*. For the shofar shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”
 - Leviticus 23:24-25
 - “Speak to the children of Israel, saying in the 7th new moon, on the 1st day of the new moon, you have a Shabbat, a remembrance of Teruah. You do not servile work and you shall bring an offering made by fire to Yahweh.”
 - Yom Teruah – the Day of Trumpets

Fall Moedim Return

- We know we have atonement for our sins through the **blood** of Yahshua
 - Only the High Priest can carry out this duty
 - Sprinkling of the blood on the people, alter, etc.
 - Yahshua became the heavenly High Priest when the veil rent from the top to the bottom
 - Teshuva is required for the atoning blood to cover us (Acts 3:19-20)
 - “Repent (Teshuva) therefore and turn back, for the blotting out of your sins, in order that times of refreshing might come from the presence of the Master and He sends Yahshua Messiah, pre-appointed for you, whom heaven needs to receive until the time of **restoration** of all matters, of which Elohim spoke through the mouth of all His set-apart prophets since of old”

Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement)

Leviticus 23:25-32

“And יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying, On the tenth day of this seventh new *moon* is Yom ha Kippurim. It shall be a set-apart gathering for you. And you shall afflict your beings, and shall bring an offering made by fire to יהוה. “And you do no work on that same day, for it is Yom Kippurim, to make atonement for you before יהוה your Elohim. For any being who is not afflicted on that same day, he shall be cut off from his people. And any being who does any work on that same day, that being I shall destroy from the midst of his people. You do no work – a law forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. ‘It is a Sabbath of rest to you, and you shall afflict your beings. On the ninth day of the new *moon* at evening, from evening to evening, you observe your Sabbath.”

Hebrews 9:18-22

“Therefore not even the first covenant was instituted without blood. For when, according to the Torah, every command had been spoken by Mosheh to all the people, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people, saying “This is the blood of the covenant which Elohim commanded you.” And in the same way he sprinkled with blood both the Tent and all the vessels of the service. And according to the Torah, *almost all is cleansed with blood*, and without shedding of *blood* there is *no forgiveness of sins*”

Atoning blood

- Before Messiah's sacrifice
 - Blood of bulls and goats was the only way for atonement
- After Messiah's sacrifice
 - *Yahshua's blood is the ONLY WAY* for atonement
- It will be on Yom Ha Kippurim that Yahshua carries out His High Priestly duty

Bought with a Price

- **1 Corinthians 6:19-20**
 - “Or do you not know that your body is the Dwelling Place of the Set-apart Spirit who is in you, which you have from Elohim, and you are not your own? For you were bought with a price, therefore esteem Elohim in your body and in your spirit, which are of Elohim.”
- **1 Corinthians 7:23-24**
 - “You were bought with a price, do not become slaves of men. Brothers, let each one remain with Elohim in that calling in which he was called.”

We are redeemed by the **Blood**

- **1 Peter 1:18-19**

- “knowing that you were redeemed from your futile behavior inherited from your fathers, not with what is corruptible, silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Messiah, as a lam unblemished and spotless”

- **Hebrews 9:11-12**

- “But Messiah, having become a High Priest of the coming good matters, through the greater and more perfect Tent not made with hands, that is not of this creation, entered into the Most Set-apart place once for all, not with the blood of goats and calves, but with HIS OWN BLOOD, having obtained everlasting redemption

Sukkot

- **The moedim – the marriage supper of Yahshua and His bride (those He has redeemed). It will only be for the set-apart ones, the chosen. Not everyone shall enter, who did He come for?**



Who did He come for?

- **The lost sheep of the House of Israel**
 - **Matthew 10:5-6**
 - Yahshua sent these 12 out, having commended them “Do not go into the way of the nations, and do not enter a city of Shmeronim, but rather go to the lost sheep of the House of Yisrael”
 - **John 10:14-16**
 - “I am the good shepperd. And I know Mine, and Mine know Me, even as the Father knows Me, and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. And other sheep I have which are not of this fold – I have to bring them as well, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one flock, one shepherd.”

- **John 10:24-29**

- **“So the Yehudim surrounded Him and said to Him. “How long do You keep us in suspense? If you are the Messiah, say to us plainly.” Yahshua answered them, “I have told you and you do not believe. The works I do in My Father’s name, they bear witness concerning Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. My sheep hear My voice and I know them, and they follow me. And I give them everlasting life, and they shall by no means ever perish, and no one shall snatch them out of My hand. My father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all. And no one is able to snatch them out of My Father’s hand.”**

- **Matthew 15:24**
 - “And He answering, said, “I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Yisrael.”
- **Ezekiel 47:21-23**
 - “And you shall divide this land among yourselves according to the tribes of Yisrael. And it shall be that you divide it by lot as an inheritance for yourselves, and for the strangers who sojourn in your midst and who bear children among you. And they shall be to you as native-born among the children of Yisrael – with you they have an inheritance in the midst of the tribes of Yisrael. And it shall be that in whatever tribe the stranger sojourns, there you give him his inheritance,” declares the Master Yahweh.”

THE JUBILEE PRINCIPLE

LEVITICUS 25:

- 8 'And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you **FORTY-NINE YEARS**.
- 9 'Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the **Day of Atonement** you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.
- 10 'And you shall **consecrate** the **FIFTIETH YEAR**, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a **JUBILEE** for you; and **each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.**

Year of Jubilee is a Sabbath

Shabbat Shalom

- **Jubilee is a Sabbatical year – a year of rest**
- **The Sabbath is a sign that we are set-apart (kadosh), holy**
- **The Shabbat is the ONLY SIGN that He sanctifies us.**

Obedience

Are we obedient only when it makes sense to us?

Or, only when we “feel” like it?

If so, then are we really being obedient?

1 Peter 2:7-10

*“This preciousness, then, is for you who believe; but to those who are disobedient, **“The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief corner-stone,”** and **“A stone of stumbling and a rock that makes for falling,”** who stumble because they are disobedient to the Word, to which they also were appointed. **But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a set-apart nation, a people for a possession,** that you should proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvellous light, **who once were not a people, but now the people of Elohim; who had not obtained compassion, but now obtained compassion.**”*

Keeping all the Sabbaths

- **To Honor and Keep (Guard) the Sabbaths**
 - It is an act of FAITH
 - It is an act of OBEDIENCE
- **If we believe what Yahweh says, we will do as HE says. With this we find shalom (Peace)**
