




## Torah



#### Message

- Offerings in this Torah Portion
  - Guilt
  - Ascending
  - Peace
  - Grain
  - Aaron and His sons
  - Sin

- Not all sins have a death penalty attached to them?
  - How many people knew that?
  - Christendom lumps all sin, even the ones they created (no alcohol allowed) together and if you sin, you go to hell (sheol / death)

## **Guilt Offering**

- Sins and Trespasses and Lies about
  - Deposit
  - Pledge
  - Robbery
  - Extortion
  - Finding something that's not yours
  - Swear falsely

- What are we to do?
  - Rectify by returning what was taken + 1/5 value
  - Then bring the guilt offering before Yahweh
    - To the Priest and the Priest shall make atonement

- Yahshua is our High Priest
  - Atonement for us comes through Him

#### **Ascending Offering**

- Burned at the Slaughter place
  - Currently do not have the physical Temple
    - We cannot complete this portion as directed

- How can we fulfill this as best as we can
  - Our Prayers are an ascending offering heard by Yahweh
    - They are accepted because we Shema

#### **Grain Offering / Aaron and His Sons**

- We are unable to complete these offerings
  - Specifically for Aaron and his children

## Sin Offering

- In the place of the ascending offering
  - Not available
    - Priest who makes atonement, eats the offering in the set-apart place
- ONE Torah for both the Guilt and Sin
  - Torah (Instruction)

#### **Other Offerings Mentioned**

- Peace
- Thanksgiving
- Voluntary
  - Offerings are eaten the same day they are offered
    - What is left is eaten the next day
    - The third day it is burned with fire
    - HOWEVER eat on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day not accepted

#### SPEAK TO THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL

- Something applicable to all
  - Do not eat any fat, of a bull or sheep or goat. And the fat of a dead body, and the fat of what is torn, is used for any purpose, but you do not eat it at all. For whoever eats the fat of the beast of which men bring as an offering made by fire Yahweh, even the being who eats it SHALL BE **CUT OFF FROM HIS PEOPLE. And do not eat any** blood in any of your dwellings, of bird or of beast. Any being who east any blood, even that being SHALL BE CUT OFF FROM HIS PEOPLE."

#### **Familiarity**

 Do we read anywhere in the Brit HaDasha where this Leviticus passage sounds extremely familiar? The Brit portion also includes sexual immorality and together they are part of the 4 most immediate concerns that need address. The rest will be heard on the Synagogue on Shabbat?

#### Speak to the Children of Israel

- He who brings the offering...with his own hands
  - The males were actively involved in the peace offerings
- Chapter 7 closes
  - On the day when He commanded the children of Yisra'el to bring their offerings to Yahweh, in the wilderness of Sinai.

#### Blessings for the Matriarchs

An accomplished woman who can find? Her value is far beyond rubies. Her husband's heart trusts in her, and he lacks nothing valuable. She brings him good and not harm all the days of her life. She selects wool and flax and her hands work willingly. She is like merchant ships, bringing her sustenance from afar. She rises while it is still night and provides food for her household and portions for her servant girls. She considers a field and buys it. From the fruit of her hands she plants a vineyard. She girds herself with strength and invigorates her arms. She discerns that her business is good. Her lamp never goes out at night. She extends her hands to the spindle and her palm grasps the spinning wheel. She spreads out her palms to the poor, and extends her hands to the needy.

#### Blessing for the Mothers

She is not afraid of snow for her house, for her whole household is clothed in scarlet wool. She makes her own luxurious coverings. Her clothing is fine linen and purple. Her husband is respected at the city gates, when he sits among the elders of the land. She makes linen garments and sells them and supplies sashes to the merchants. Strength and dignity are her clothing, and she laughs at the days to come. She opens her mouth with wisdom— a lesson of kindness is on her tongue. She watches over the affairs of her household, and does not eat the bread of idleness. Her children arise and bless her, her husband also praises her: "Many daughters have excelled, but you surpass them all." Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears YAHWEH will be praised. Give her the fruit of her hands. Let her deeds be her praise at the gates.
