PORTION IN A NUTSHELL


MASSEI: JOURNEYS

Yahweh recounted Israel's journey from the first place to the last. Yahweh told Moshe to tell the people to pass over the Jordan River into the land of Canaan. They were to drive out the inhabitants of the land and destroy all their figured stones and metal images. They were to demolish their high places. Yahweh told Moshe the boundaries of their new land. Yahweh explained to Moshe how to give cities within the other tribes' lands for the Levites. Yahweh explained to Moshe what cities of refuge were and where they were to be in each tribe's settlement. Yahweh explained the laws of the marriage of female heirs to

Moshe. They were only allowed to marry within their own tribe if they wanted to keep their inheritance but they could choose their own husbands. If they married outside of their tribe, they forfeited their inheritance.

Pro 14:26 "In the fear of Yahweh [is] strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of **refuge**."

Hbr 6:18 "That by two immutable things, in which [it was] impossible for Yahweh to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for **refuge** to lay hold upon the hope set before us:"

YOU ARE MY HIDING PLACE: 101

I know that I have had some seriously bad days in the past. It used to be that I would run to my room, lay in my bed, and lock the door. I wanted to be alone. I didn't want to be around anyone because my day was so awful. One day, I realized that seeking refuge for just a short time in my bedroom helped just for a short time. Now, I have had a realization. Yahweh is our refuge! The Bible says that He is our hiding place and our place of refuge. We can find protection and shelter in Him. You might wonder how in the world you can hide in Yahweh, right? Well, its simple... when you find yourself in a bad situation or in a bad day, rest assured as you pray and/or

seek His word that you are safe in His promises, His forgiveness, His mercy, His grace, and His newness. His mercies are new every morning. NO MATTER WHAT, if you seek His''s face, His forgiveness, and His path, you will be safe from danger or distress.

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SEEK REFUGE!

Yahweh instructed the people about cities of refuge. There were six cities altogether. These cities were places that people could go to receive a fair sentence in cases of accidental death. Read more in Numbers 35.

Psalm 91:9-11 Because you have made Yahweh, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place, No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.

REFUGE (n.) shelter or protection from danger or distress.
