Training our youth to be sons and daughters of the commandments.

"If you love me, keep my commandments." Yashua (John 14:15)

PORTION IN A NUTSHELL

RETH (SEE)

Yahweh set before the people a blessing and a curse. The blessing was for obeying the commandments and the curse was for disobeying the commandments. The blessing was to be set on Mount Gerizim and the curse on Mount Ebal in the land of the Canaanites. Yahweh commanded the people to tear down the altars and places of worship of the people in the land. Yahweh promises to choose a place for his Name and his habitation. This is where the people were to worship and make offerings to Him. Once all the enemies were defeated, the people were to rejoice before Yahweh our Elohim. Yahweh told Israel that they could eat meat in their towns but they could not eat their tithe or their offerings in their towns. They could only eat those things in the place that Yahweh will choose and there they will rejoice before Yahweh our Elohim. The people are reminded not to eat the blood because blood is life and they shall not eat the life with the flesh. It was to be poured out onto the earth like water. The people were to be careful to do all that Yahweh commands. Yahweh forbids Israel to worship Him the same way that the nations worshipped their gods. The nations have done every abominable thing that Yahweh hates. Israel is reminded not to add to or take away from the things that Yahweh commands them to do. If a prophet or dreamer of dreams gives the people a sign or a wonder and it comes to pass and he tells Israel to follow after other gods and serve them, they are not to listen to the words. This is because it is a way for Yahweh to test Israel to see if they fear Him and will hold tightly to Him. The false prophet or dreamer of dreams is to be put to death. Those who try to lead Israel away from Yahweh were to be put to death with stones. This way, Israel shall hear and fear and never do any wickedness. If they obey, Yahweh will show them mercy and compassion and multiply them as He promised. The people were not to do any rituals for the dead. They were to be holy to Yahweh our Elohim. They were to eat clean foods only. They were not to boil a kid in its mother's milk. Israel was commanded to bring a tenth of their yield of their fields, grain, wine, and oil to Yahweh. They were also asked to give the firstborn of their herds and clocks. If there were too far away and could not bring it, they were to sell their tithe and

spend the money on whatever they wanted to: oxen, sheep, wine, or strong drink, or whatever they desired. They were not to neglect the Levites in their towns. At the end of three years, they were to bring out all the tithe foods and put it in their towns. There, the Levite, sojourner, fatherless, and widows shall all come, eat, and be filled so that Yahweh our Elohim may bless Israel in the works of their hands. Yahweh teaches the people about the Sabbatical Year. This occurred every seven years. Yahweh teaches the people how to keep his feasts and sabbaths.



FALSE PROPHETS: 101

"I have a word from Yahweh! Yahweh is doing something new and He desires lawlessness from His people! He wants us to change his Sabbath day to Sunday, to reject His appointed times so we can observe Pagan dates, and he wants us to eat rats, bats, cats and pork. All of these new things are made clean!" Are these the words of a true prophet or a false prophet? A false prophet might be a little more subtle than that... o.k., a lot more subtle, which is why it is important that you know the Word of YHWH (the Torah), so that you will not be deceived to follow the doctrines of false prophet. The scriptures say that a false prophet will appear to be a believer (Matthew 7:15). Unfortunately, a false prophets will deceive many, but you don't have to be one of those who are deceived (Matthew 24:11, Mark 13:22). A modern day false teacher might

quote Paul out of context, without any other Biblical authors or prophecies to confirm their interpretations. Paul's words might be hard to understand, but regardless of the "good sounding" reasons the false teacher might give, YHWH'S Word stands forever (2 Peter 3:16). Would YHWH give us His Word; send His son to live it; send His Holy Spirit to write it on our hearts; and confirm it throughout all of scripture, just so he could send a prophet to tell us that His Word is lame and outdated? Doesn't that sound more like a false prophet? If you are truly following Yahshua, you will never have to worry about falling into the trap of false doctrines, because Yahshua followed his Father's commandments (John 15:10).


