Numbers/Bamidbar 19:1-22:1

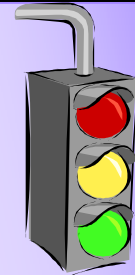
Training our youth to be sons and daughters of the commandments.

## PORTION IN A NUTSHELL

### CHUKAT (STATUTE)

Yahweh instructed Moshe and Aharon to have the people get them a red heifer without defect which has never had a yoke on it. Eleazar the priest was to oversee its sacrifice and Yahweh instructed the people what to do with the animal, the blood, and the ashes from the sacrifice. Yahweh reminds the people about the laws of purification. When the people came to the wilderness of Zin in the first month, Miriam died and was buried there. There was no water to drink. The people quarreled with Moshe because they were thirsty. Yahweh instructed Moshe to take the staff and tell the rock before their eyes to give them water. This is how Yahweh would bring water from a rock for the people and their animals to drink. Moshe took the staff and struck the rock two times and water came out for everyone and their animals to drink. Yahweh said to Moshe, "Because you didn't believe in me, to uphold me as holy in the eyes of the people of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land that I have given them. These are the waters of Meribah, where the people quarreled with Yahweh, and through them he showed himself holy." Moshe sent messengers into Edom asking them if Israel could pass through their land but the Edomites refused to give Israel passage through their territory so Israel turned away from them. When the people came to Mount Hor, Aharon died and shan't enter the land of promise because Moshe rebelled against Yahweh's command at the waters of Meribah. Eleazar (Aharon's son) was given Aharon's garments in front of the whole congregation of Israel. Everyone wept for Aharon for 30 days. Kin Arad (the Canaanite) heard Israel was coming and he fought against Israel and took some of them captive. Yahweh heard Israel's vow to devote the cities of Arad to destruction if he'd deliver them. Yahweh did as the people vowed. Israel set out to go by way of the Red Sea around Edom. The people became impatient. Yahweh sent fiery serpents among the people and they bit people and many died. The people came to Moshe and confessed that they had sinned and spoken against Yahweh and against Moshe. They asked Moshe to pray. Yahweh told Moshe to take a bronze serpent and set it on a pole. If a snake bit anyone, they could look at the bronze serpent and live. The people set out again. The people sang a song about the water of the Lord. Israel then sent messengers to the king of the Amorites asking if they could pass through. The Amorites said no. Israel defeated them and settled in their cities. They sang another song to Yahweh. Israel also defeated King Og of Bashan and possessed his land. Then Israel set out and camped in the plains of Moab beyond the Jordan River at Jericho.

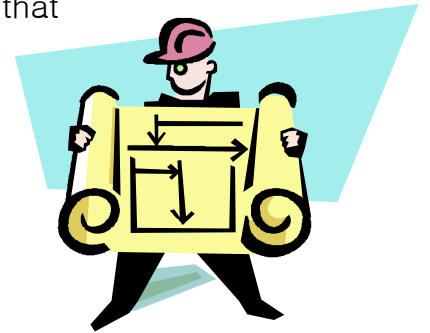
#### **2Peter 3:13-14**

As we do this, we can look forward to His promise and know that we are ready.

What are some situations you should avoid? What are some situations that you have found yourself in that were bad for your temple to be around?



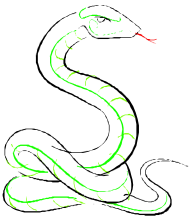

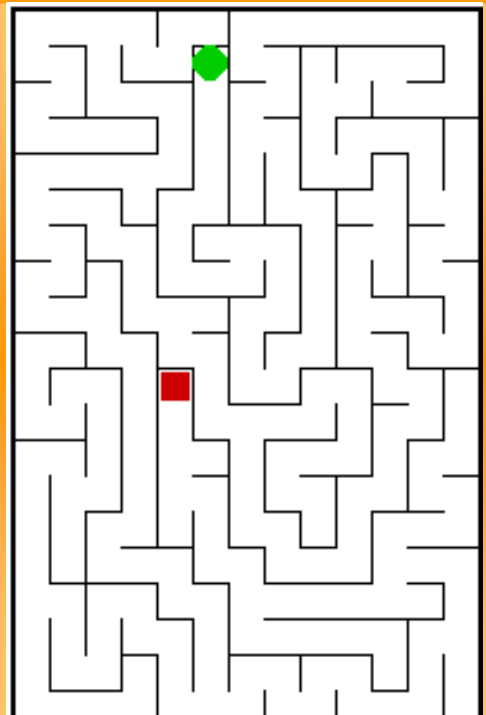

## Hebrew Vowel Points: I-Type Vowels

Vowel Mark	Vowel Name	Sound	Trans.	Class
	Chireq	"ee" as in green	i	Short
	Chireq Yod	"ee" as in green	i	Long

### Notes:

- Although these vowel marks look different, they both represent an "ee" sound.
- Note which vowel is **short** (Chirik) and which is **long** (Chirik Yod).
