PORTION IN A NUTSHELL

ACHAREI MOT (AFTER THE DEATH)

After Aarons two sons died, Yahweh told Moses that Aaron could not come into the Holy Place inside the veil without bringing a sin offering and a burnt offering. Aaron needed to put on the linen coat, undergarments, sash, and turban. He was to take a bath before putting them on. Aaron was to make an offering for himself and his household. Then, he was to cast lots over two goats. One was for Yahweh and the other for a scapegoat. Yahweh's goat was for a sin offering. The other was the be presented alive and then sent away into the wilderness as the scapegoat. Incense was to be burned before Yahweh covering the mercy seat. Blood was to be sprinkled on the mercy seat on the east side and in front of it. Atonement was to be made for the Holy Place because of the uncleanness of the people of Israel and because of their transgressions, all their sins. No one was allowed into the tent of meeting while atonement was being made. The scapegoat was sent away. Aaron was to then return to the tent of meeting. He was to take off his linen garments and leave them there. He then bathed in water in a holy place and put on his garments and came out to offer offerings to Yahweh to make atonement for himself and the people. Whoever let the scapegoat go in the wilderness had to bathe as well. This was to be the day of atonement; the tenth day of the seventh month. No work is to be done. It is a day to afflict ourselves. Atonement is made for the sanctuary, the tent of meeting, the altar, the priests, and all the people. It is a statute forever that atonement may be made for the people of Israel once a year. Moshe obeyed. Yahweh commanded that all sacrifices be brought to Him and offered to Him alone. This is a rule forever. If anyone eats blood, Yahweh's face will be set against them and they will be cut off from the people. Life is in the blood. No one among Israel nor any stranger who goes with them may eat blood. If anyone hunts animals for food, its blood is to be

poured out and covered with dirt. Whoever eats it the blood shall be cut off. No one is to eat something that dies naturally or is killed by another animal. If they do, they are to wash their clothes, take a bath, and remain unclean till evening. If they do not wash or bathe, they shall bear iniquity. Israel must not do as they did in Egypt or Canaan. Israel must follow Yahweh's rules only. They are to be pure in their relationships and not do anything that is impure, evil, or an abomination to Yahweh. Israel is to never practice any of the abominable customs of the nations. Yahweh is our Elohim.



TIME TO CHOOSE SIDES: 101

Would your mom consider it to be obedience if she told you to do the dishes and then you went to the neighbor's house and did their dishes? What if you were told to have flowers sent to a sick friend in the hospital, but you didn't send the flowers to the room until after the person went home? The right thing at the wrong time or place is the wrong thing! Concerning the sacrificial laws, YHWH told the children of Israel to bring their sacrifices to the tabernacle and not to sacrifice anywhere ex-cept there. In straying from YHWH's commandment and sacrificing to YHWH on the altars of foreign gods, they were guilty of offering their sacrifices to devils (Lev 17:7). Israel's rebellious nature looks very similar to the way we acted before we submitted to YHWH. Many of us who shared the faith in Yahshua sanctified Sunday as the day to assemble and rest, but in doing so it was observing the right thing at the wrong time. Many of us did the same things with the birth and resurrection of Yahshua, by the celebrating the birth of Yahshua on Wicca's festival of Yule (aka: Christmas) and celebrating the resurrection on the Pagan's feast of Easter. Even though we are not commanded to observe the birth or resurrection of Messiah, there is a time and a place for these observances and they are not contained within the holy days of Baal. When YHWH spoke to the assembly

in Pergamos, He confronted them concerning this thing. The assembly mixed the things of Elohim with the things of Baal. YHWH calls his people to repent and stop partaking in these practices of mixing holy with unholy, which are a type of spiritual fornication. If YHWH be Almighty, worship Him. If Baal be god, worship Him.


