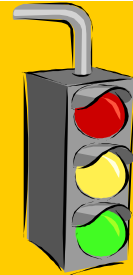
Exodus/ Shemot 27:20-30:20

"If you love me, keep my commandments." Yeshua (John 14:15)

PORTION IN A NUTSHELL

TETZAVEH (AND YOU SHALL)

Yahweh asks Moshe to make holy garments for Aharon and Aharon's sons for glory and beauty. The garments include a breast piece, an ephod, a robe, a coat of checker work, a turban, and a sash. They were to be made of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet yarns and linen. The stones on the ephod were to have the names of the 12 sons/tribes of Israel engraved upon them. The hem of the robes were to have designs like pomegranates and bells sewn onto them. Yahweh wanted the priests to be consecrated to him. This was done with an animal sacrifice. Yahweh promises to dwell among Israel and be their Elohim. Yahweh tells them to build an altar for incense out of acacia wood. It is to be overlaid with gold. The altar is to go in front of the veil that is above the ark of the testimony in the Most Holy Place. Yahweh tells Aharon to burn fragrant incense on it in the morning as an offering before Yahweh. With the blood of the sin offering, an atonement is to be made once in the year throughout all of our generations. It is most holy to Yahweh.



Ephesians 6:13-17 Therefore put on the full armor of Yahweh, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of Yahweh.

Revelation 1:5-6 Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits before his throne, and from Yahshua Messiah, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve His Elohim and Father—to him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from Yahweh? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor Yahweh with your body.

HOLY WARDROBE: 101

In Exodus 28 Yahweh commanded Moshe to make Aaron and his sons as ministers of the priest's office. Yahweh also instructed Moshe to choose wise-hearted people, who were filled with the spirit of wisdom, to make holy garments for Aaron and his sons that they would wear as they served Yahweh.

In Revelation 1:6 we are told that Yeshua has made us kings and priests unto Elohim. We might not be priests of the temple that is built with hands, but we are kings and priests of our own bodies. 1Corinthians 6:19 says, "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (Ruach HaChodesh) which is in you, which ye have of Elohim, and ye are not your own?" Being that we are in charge of our temples (bodies), we are told to glorify Elohim in our bodies, by making the outside line up with what is written inside (Jer 31:33, Rom 2:13-15).

Just as Aaron and his sons were to wear holy garments, we are also to wear holy garments. This is not to say we need to go out and buy or make special clothes to wear, but these garments are spiritual in order to help us be able to stand against evil (Eph 6:11). We are told to put on the whole armor of Elohim and stand firm with the belt of truth, breastplate of righteousness, our feet fitted with preparation, the shield of faith, helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of Elohim (Eph 6:11-17).

MODESTY, HONESTLY

To be modest on the outside, keep your actions and dress appropriate and glorifying to Yahweh.

HEBREW LANGUAGE

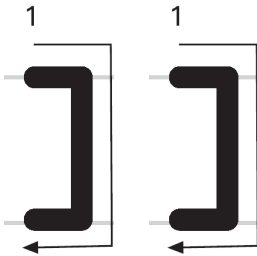


Nun is the 14th letter in the Alef Bet. It is the number 50. It symbolizes a sprout and means "continue or heir."

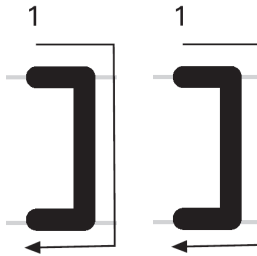

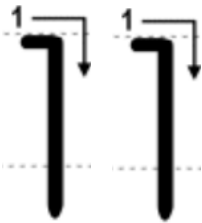

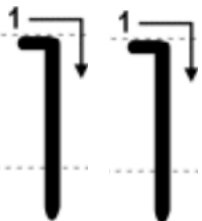
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
