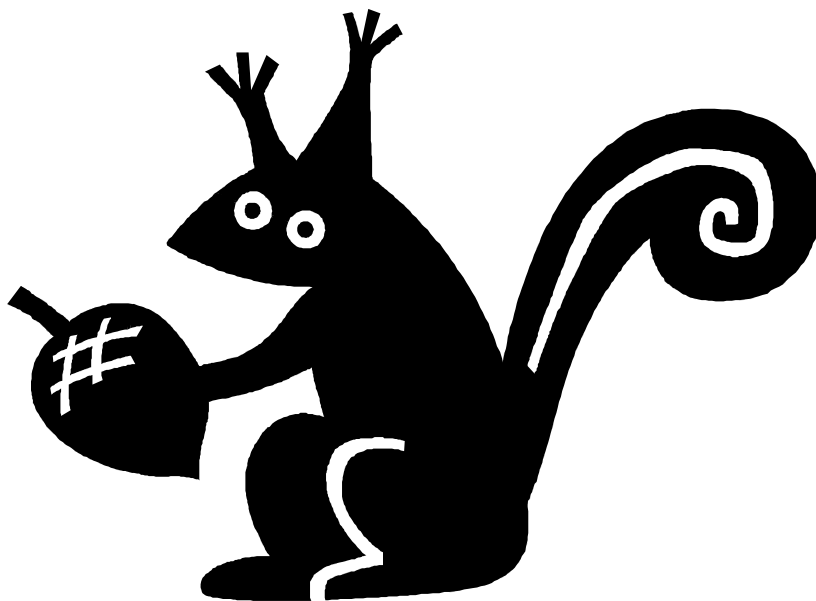

PORTION IN A NUTSHELL

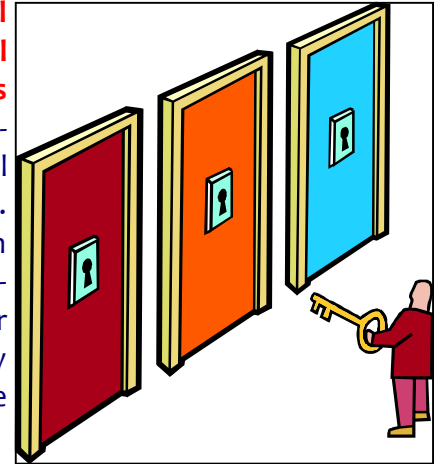
HA A'ZINU (HEAR)

Moshe sings a song to the people. The song is about giving glory to Yahweh and about Israel's decisions. Yahweh is great. His work is perfect. His ways are just. He is faithful. He is upright. He is our Father and our Creator. We can ask Him questions. We can ask our elders questions too. We are Yahweh's portion. Israel is the apple of His eye. Yahweh took care of Israel but Israel made Him jealous. They made bad choices. They went after other gods and idols. That made Yahweh very angry. The enemies of Israel are heathen nations. Yahweh will rescue His people. He will have compassion on His servants. There is no god beside Him. Heaven rejoices with Him and everyone bows to Him. When Moshe finished singing, he warned the people. He warned them to be careful to do all the words of the law. It is not an empty word. It is our very life. By this word we shall love long in the land that we are to possess. Yahweh spoke to Moshe on Mount Nebo in the land of Moab. Moshe could see Canaan (the land of promise) from the mountaintop. But because Moshe broke faith with Yahweh in the wilderness of Zin, and did not treat Yahweh as holy in the midst of the people, he was not permitted to enter Canaan. Moshe was to die on the mountain as Aaron died on Mount Hor.



DO WHAT IS GOOD AND RIGHT: 101

Have you ever watched a movie where the main character has a really great life but slowly you see him completely throw it away? Where did you see that person heading for destruction? While sitting on the edge of your seat, did you want to reach through the television and smack them to wake them up? Questions flood your mind like, “Will it work out? Will they get it? How will it end?” This **week’s Torah Portion brings to light, once again, YHWH giving a cause and effect scenario and helping us avoid making bad choices.** YHWH also outlines His response to our decisions, both good and bad through Jacob’s heritage (vs.10-14) and Jeshurun’s unfaithfulness (vs. 15-38). **Time and time again we have had the benefit of learning from the children of Israel’s mistakes and hopefully avoiding the same.** If only everything came with a disclosure of what would happen if...? How much more would we avoid in our lives?!? All through scriptures we are reminded of how our choices could result in blessings. **“Be careful to obey all these regulations I am giving you, so that it may always go well with you and your children after you, because you will be doing what is good and right in the eyes of YHWH your Elohim!”** Due to Moses’ unfaithfulness, he was unable to enter into the promised land (vs. 52). YHWH still loved him and by faith Moses was still counted as faithful (Hebrews 3:5). YHWH will still love us with that everlasting love (Psalm 103:17-18, Jeremiah 31:3) even if we become that character to throw it all away. YHWH may allow us to go through the consequences, but in the end He is still there for us (unlike the pagan gods). I hope to take advantage of seeing all the many mistakes made before me and avoid the same in my life, so that it will be well with me!!!
