

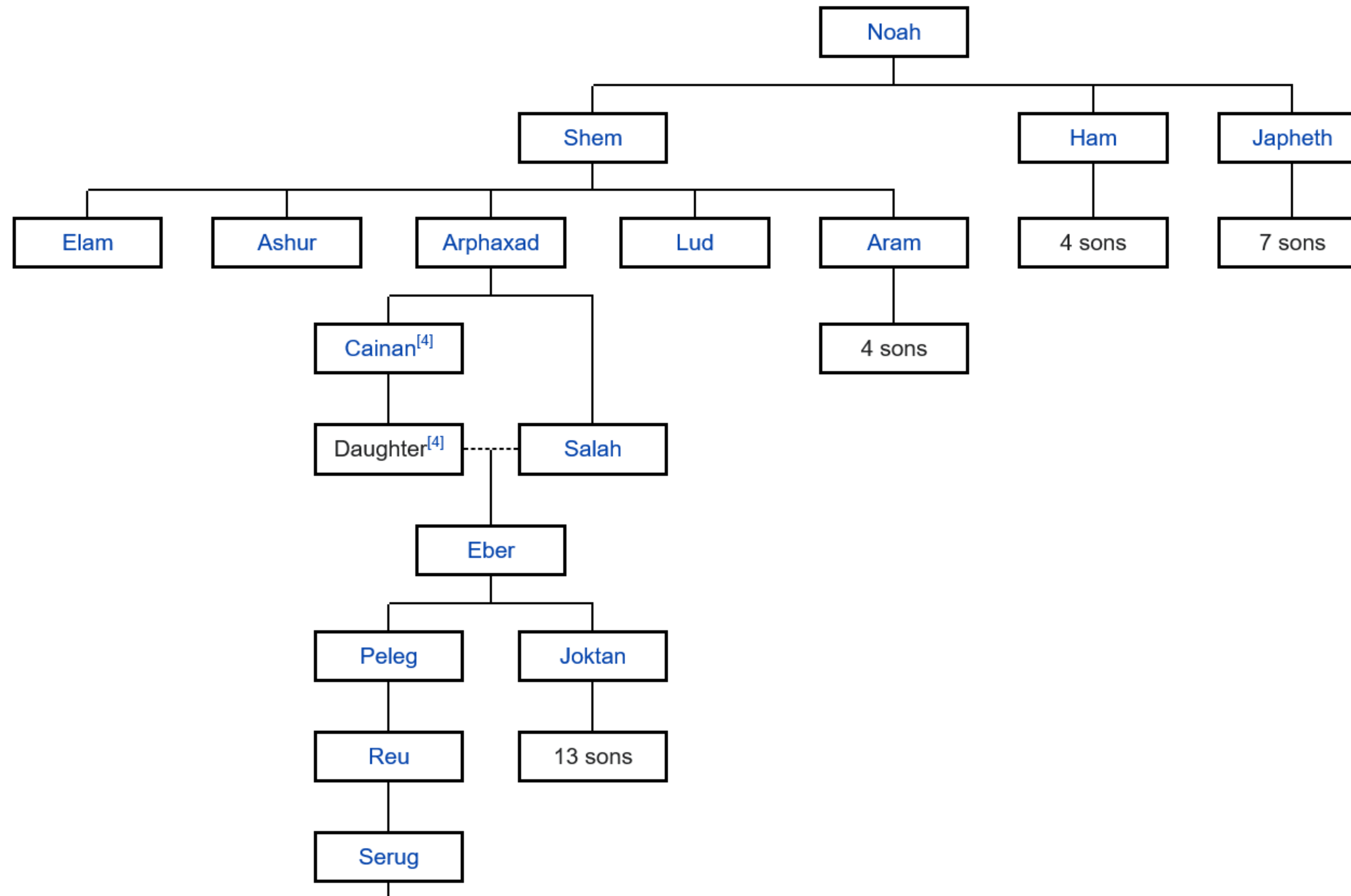

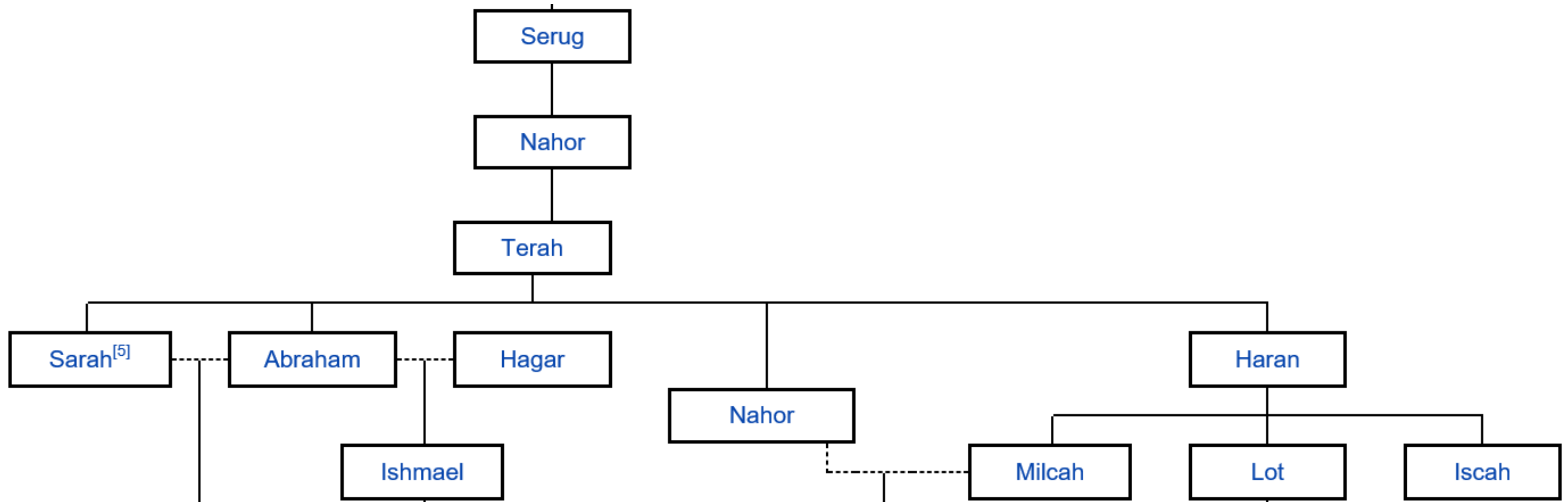

Revelation 1

To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood **6** and made us a kingdom, priests to his Almighty and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. **7** Behold, He is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him, and **all tribes of the earth** will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.

8 “I am the Alef and the Taw,” says the Yahweh Almighty, “**who is** and **who was** and **who is to come**, the Almighty.”

Genesis 14 | Abram Blessed by Melchizedek

This Melchizedek was king of *Salem* and priest of Yahweh Most High. He met Abraham returning from the defeat of the kings and blessed him, **2** and Abraham gave him a tenth of everything. First, the name Melchizedek means “**king of righteousness**”; then also, “king of Salem” means “**king of peace.**” **3** Without father or mother, without genealogy, without beginning of days or end of life, resembling the Son of Yahweh, he remains a priest forever. Hebrews 7

- Melchizedek was king of Salem.
- "Salem" comes from the Hebrew word meaning "[peace](#)."
- That would make Melchizedek the "King of Peace"
- The Hebrew name Melchizedek itself means "**King of Righteousness**"
- [Psalm 110:4](#). Speaking prophetically of Mashiach, David stated: "The Eternal hath sworn, and will not [repent](#), Thou art a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek."

The Priest of the Most High Elohim

Genesis 14:18-20

18 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out *bread and wine*. He was priest of Yahweh Most High, **19** and he blessed Abram, saying, “Blessed be Abram by Yahweh Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. **20** And praise be to Yahweh Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.” Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything.

And he took **bread**, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.” And likewise **the cup** after they had eaten, saying, “This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.

From Everlasting

Psalm 90

A prayer of Moses the man of Elohim. Yah, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are Elohim.

- "without mother, without father, without descent,"
- Without such records, human priests could not serve!

Ezra 2:62

61 And from among the priests: The descendants of Hobaiah, Hakkoz and Barzillai (a man who had married a daughter of Barzillai the Gileadite and was called by that name). **62 These searched for their family records, but they could not find them and so were excluded from the priesthood as unclean.** **63** The governor ordered them not to eat any of the most sacred food until there was a priest ministering with the Urim and Thummim.

Jun, are there three High Priests'? Melchizedek, Levitical, Yahshua

Hebrews 8

Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, **2** a minister in the holy places, in the true tent that Yahweh set up, not man. **3** For every high priest is appointed to offer gifts and sacrifices; thus it is necessary for this priest also to have something to offer. **4** Now if He were on earth, he would not be a priest at all, since there are priests who offer gifts according to the law.

5 They serve **a copy and shadow of the heavenly things.** For when Moses was about to erect the tent, he was instructed by Yahweh, saying, “***See that you make everything according to the pattern that was shown you on the mountain.***” **6** But as it is, Mashiach has obtained a ministry that is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises. **7** For if that first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no occasion to look for a second.

- It is the function of the High Priest to lead the way to salvation.
- Yahshua the author and finisher of our faith (hebrews 12:2)

Hebrews 5:9-10

9 And being made perfect, He became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him, **10** being designated by Yahweh a High Priest after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 6:19-20

19 We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. It enters the inner sanctuary behind the curtain, **20** where our forerunner, Yahshua, has entered on our behalf. **He has become a high priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek.**
